CLINICAL TRIAL

NAME OF STUDY:

The T-Trial (The Testosterone Trial)

TYPE OF VOLUNTEERS BEING SOUGHT:

Men, age 65 and older, with any of the following problems that may indicate a low level of testosterone:

- (1) Trouble walking a quarter mile
- (2) Decreased interest in sex
- (3) Decreased energy

PURPOSE OF STUDY:

To determine if testosterone gel treatment for one year in men, age 65 and older with significantly decreased levels of testosterone, will help alleviate the symptoms listed above, compared to men using a placebo (inactive) gel.

DETAILS OF STUDY:

Approximately 4-5 million American men have low levels of testosterone. Though some of these men have medical problems leading to low levels, testosterone levels can fall on their own with age, affecting physical and sexual function. LA BioMed is one of twelve sites across the United States studying the effectiveness of a daily testosterone replacement gel among a total of 800 men.

Research volunteers will be asked to be in contact with the research center for one year of active study, followed by a year of follow-up, for a total of approximately 10 visits, including a screening test to determine eligibility. During these visits, the research volunteers will go through complete medical and physical exams, provide blood samples for measurement of levels of hormones, perform tests of activity and/or fill out various surveys regarding their experiences using the gel. Compensation will be provided for time and travel.
